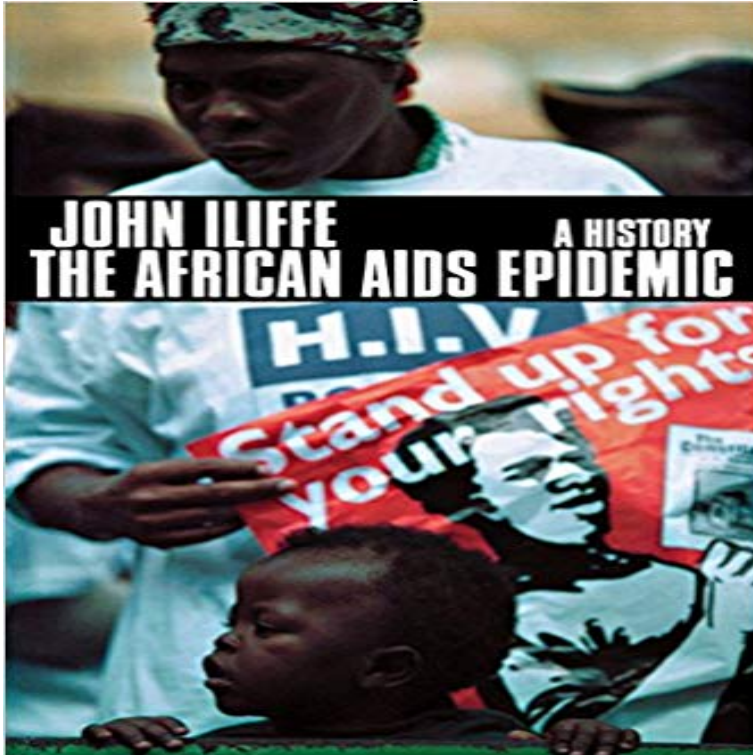


The African AIDS Epidemic: A History
